GRIEF SHARE

How GriefShare works

It may be hard for you to feel optimistic about the future right now. If you've lost a spouse, child, family member, or friend, you've probably found there are not many people who understand the deep hurt you feel.

This can be a confusing time when you feel isolated and have many questions about things you've never faced before.

"Going to GriefShare feels like having warm arms wrapped around you when you're shivering."

GriefShare groups meet weekly to help you face these challenges and move toward rebuilding your life. Each GriefShare session has three distinct elements:



Video seminar with experts

Each week your GriefShare group will watch a video seminar featuring top experts on grief and recovery subjects. These videos are produced in an interesting television magazine format featuring expert interviews, real-life case studies, dramatic reenactments, and on-location video.

Support group discussion with focus

After viewing the video, you and the other group members will spend time as a support group, discussing what was presented in that week's video seminar and what is going on in your lives.

Personal study and reflection

During the week you will have the opportunity to use your workbook for further personal study of the grieving process and to help sort out your emotions through journaling. Your group will spend time discussing questions and comments from the workbook study.

Bishop's Monthly Reflection

February 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Within the Biblical mindset, the *heart* was seen as the very core of human being. Everything was rooted in and issued forth from the heart. One's relationship with God was seen, centered and treasured in the heart of the believer.

It was the appointed time of the Incarnation that the Son of God took on a *human* heart in order to transmit to the hearts of the people his unconditional love. It is within the pierced-Sacred-Heart, filled with compassion and tender mercy, that our human hearts, wounded by sin, are redeemed and saved.

In the Scriptures, we hear of the Lord's Mother, Mary, Our Blessed Mother, and how she treasured and pondered all in her *Immaculate* Heart which was wounded through the passion and death of her Son. Even today, her maternal heart continues to experience sorrow. She reminds us of her heart surrounded and pierced by the thorns of the sins of hardened and unrepentant hearts.

Now, as we find ourselves in the month of February, with its traditional celebration of St. Valentine's Day, the heart takes center stage as a popular symbolic expression of love and friendship. Spiritually speaking, may we reflect upon this powerful symbol and ponder the unconditional love Jesus has for us; to love him above all things and to embrace his mandate to love one another as we love ourselves.

The following words of the prophet Ezekiel can assist us in setting the tone in our preparation for the upcoming penitential season of conversion-Lent:

"I will give you a new heart and place a new spirit within you, taking from your bodies your stony hearts and giving you natural hearts."

Let us pray that this transformation, this conversion of heart, will become a reality in the hearts of those who have fallen away from God and his love.

May the Immaculate and Sorrowful Heart of Mary lead us to the Sacred and Eucharistic Heart of her Son, Jesus. Amen
