-Confronting these Urgent Times-

My brothers and sisters, beginning with the month of August, we acknowledge our annual celebrations in honor of Our Lady. First, we honor the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin, then, in the month of September, celebrate the feast of her Birth. These celebrations will, then, point to the month of October when we will acknowledge the importance of the Rosary, along with the anniversary of the last apparition of Fatima. It was there, in Fatima, that the Blessed Virgin identified herself as the Lady of the Rosary.



The Holy Rosary can provide us with a graced opportunity to reflect upon the urgent state of affairs of our day and age. Spiritually speaking, our devotion and celebrations in honor of Our Lady will help to restore a sense of interior peace of mind and heart for those without hope. She assures us that by placing trust in her Immaculate Heart and faithfully praying the Rosary, that this will be key to the restoration of order – peace in this world. As we: pray, offer penance, and participate in devotions centered on the Eucharist, the peace that God will grant to humanity will prove to be contrary to the fragile peace the world has to offer. The peace of God is lasting and life-changing! In order to be effective, prayer and penance must be intentional. All of this must be done in reparation for the sins of our nation and the world. If we persevere in doing this, then we will be faithful to Our Lady in responding to her call to offer prayer and sacrifices for the conversion of poor sinners.

Today, we face an urgent call to focus upon and be renewed by Truth! We are to avoid being caught up in what the Venerable Sister Lúcia dos Santos, one of the visionaries of Fatima, termed as “diabolical disorientation.” Her term is in agreement with the warning found in the letter to the Hebrews 13:9a – “Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teaching.” Also, Paul’s letter to the Romans reminds us: “Do not conform yourselves to this age but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, so that you may judge what is God’s will, what is good, pleasing and perfect.” (Rom 12:2) We are called to be faithful to the Gospel. We are to take to heart Jesus’ mandate: “Repent!”

According to Sr. Lúcia, the last spiritual battle to be waged by Satan will be fought over marriage and the family. Once these fundamentals of society are dismantled, the result is chaos, disorder, confusion, darkness – disorientation! We are experiencing and living this now! The basic revealed truths of God, dealing with marriage and family life, are under attack. This spiritual warfare needs to be fought – spiritually! I feel we are quickly coming to a crossroads of God’s mercy and the manifestation of his justice – the repercussions of our sins. The spiritual, social, cultural, political, and natural order of things is being impacted by the denial of the existence of God, his Law, and the failure to acknowledge sin for what it is and to repent of it. As a result, we are faced with consequences - the present state of affairs with all its hardships, disillusionment, and hopelessness.

Because of this, I ask that all of our parishes intentionally promote the Rosary, now, as we anticipate the month of October. This can be done by simply inviting people to gather for prayer; offering a catechesis on the Rosary; organizing rosary processions and rallies; sharing the message of Fatima and, all the while, focusing on the Eucharist Revival. Today, people need encouragement. What is needed is a revival, a renewed sense of hope in the midst of these disoriented times. Let us renew our devotion to the Holy Rosary. Let us experience this special prayer and know the power of the Immaculate Heart of Mary in addressing these urgent times. As Our Lady of the Rosary assured Lúcia, so she assures us: “I will be your Refuge” – “I will lead you to God.” “In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph!”

This can be a confusing time when you feel isolated and have many questions about things you've never faced before.

GriefShare groups meet weekly to help you face these challenges and move toward rebuilding your life. Each GriefShare session has three distinct elements:

YOUR JOURNEY FROM MOURNING TO JOY

Video seminar with experts

Each week your GriefShare group will watch a video seminar featuring top experts on grief and recovery subjects. These videos are produced in an interesting television magazine format featuring expert interviews, real-life case studies, dramatic reenactments, and on-location video.

Support group discussion with focus

After viewing the video, you and the other group members will spend time as a support group, discussing what was presented in that week's video seminar and what is going on in your lives.

Personal study and reflection

During the week you will have the opportunity to use your workbook for further personal study of the grieving process and to help sort out your emotions through journaling. Your group will spend time discussing questions and comments from the workbook study.

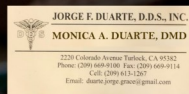

A group from the Holy Land (Bethlehem & Jerusalem) will be selling religious articles after Masses this weekend to support the Catholic Christian minorities in Bethlehem.

As a tradition, many of the Catholic families in the Holy Land work in small workshops to produce religious articles from olive wood. These articles represent the Christian art of the Holy Land. In the past, they used to sell their artwork to pilgrims who visited the Holy Land. However, they are facing an economic hardship, as there are fewer tourists visiting the Holy Land due to the pandemic. Many of the Catholic families immigrated and left the Holy Land. The percentage of Christians in the Holy Land has dropped from 20% to less than 1%. We believe that in a few years, there will be no Catholics in Bethlehem or Jerusalem. The struggle to preserve the Catholic identity of the birthplace of our savior, Jesus Christ, is a serious concern for Catholics around the world. Sales will be used to help and support the Catholics in the Holy Land and to encourage them not to immigrate.

City of Turlock, We Care Program join forces to open day center to provide safe, cool place for adults

TURLOCK, CA. – The City of Turlock and the We Care Program have launched a day center open to all residents looking to connect with social services or just needing a cool, safe place to relax and socialize. The center is located at 275 Third St. and can be accessed through the United Samaritans Foundation parking lot on Broadway. It is open from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday. Anyone 18 and older is welcome to use the center, which features an air-conditioned space with restrooms, TV, water and coffee. It is open to all adults in the community – not just those who are part of the We Care Program. Since the center began operations Wednesday, June 7th, 2023 nearly 400 people have dropped by. There is a housing manager who can help those in need of shelter as well as a social services case worker from La Familia. Once a month, a physician from Community Health Centers of America provides free medical access. “The success of this program is already higher than anticipated,” said Maris Sturtevant, Executive Director of the We Care Program. “The center creates a safe place for people to use the restrooms and rest during the day that is not the streets and sidewalks. Already, we are seeing clients using this time to connect to new jobs, resources and housing. The dedicated staff has helped community members by providing someplace to be and someone to talk to who wants to help.” “We are delighted to join with We Care to create this new navigation center. Our goal is to help people access all needed services and job opportunities. Over the next few months we will evaluate the impact and explore ways to make it better”, said Reagan Wilson, Turlock City Manager. Jeffrey Lewis, President and CEO of Legacy Health Endowment in Turlock, praised the partnership that led to the center. “The City of Turlock keeps moving forward to ensure that any resident who needs a place to cool or get warm has somewhere to go,” he said. “Along with We Care, this ongoing commitment to ensure residents are protected from the heat and the cold underscores a commitment to humanity.”
