BISHOP'S MONTHLY REFLECTION December 2023

II Corinthians 1:3-5

"Praise be God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the god of all consolation! He comforts us in all our afflictions and thus enables us to comfort those who are in trouble with the same consolation we have received from him. As we have shared much in the suffering of Christ, so through Christ do we share abundantly in his consolation."

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Advent Season and the light that it brings begs us to turn to God for his *consolation*, and it challenges us to *comfort* others "who are in trouble." This recommendation of St. Paul to the Corinthians is also meant for us, especially during this holy season of expectation and hope. With Advent, we begin a new liturgical year, and one of the clarion proclamations, expressed in word and song is:

"Comfort, comfort My people." Is. 40:1

This *heavenly* consolation and comfort begins with a God who loves and is concerned with our wellbeing: "the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies." It is in the Person of the Messiah, Jesus, that we have received: Light, consolation, and hope. As we embrace this truth, we must persevere in knowing that the Father comforts us in all of our afflictions as he did with his Son, Jesus. Even during Jesus' terrible passion and death, in the midst of experiencing the darkness of abandonment, Jesus persevered and trusted his *merciful* Father.

During these uncertain times of wars and violence, hatred, lawlessness, and division, in the midst of all of this, we, too, can experience an oppressive sense of abandonment. It is a darkness that can settle over us in order to disillusion and rob us of hope. But we must be reassured that God, the Father of Mercies, has *not* abandoned us.

We, during this Advent season, need to be a *people of hope*. Once we are secure in hope, then we can be true instruments of encouragement and consolation to our brothers and sisters who are fearful and who are struggling in this life. As we share and unite our afflictions to those of Christ, so in Christ, we will "share abundantly in his consolation."

May the holy season of Light, *consolation, and comfort*-Advent-prepare, strengthen, and illuminate our minds and hearts as we await the Coming of Jesus. During this Advent and Christmas Season, let us welcome He, who **is** *Comfort*, who was sent by the Father-*Emmanuel!*

"Let us be comforted!"

"Let us embrace the Light!"



This past week, we had the great blessing and grace of our Advent Parish Mission with Fr. Wade Menezes, CPM, preaching to us on the Eucharist: Gift and Sacrament. We give thanks to God for stirring our hearts to be moved and inspired with an ever-greater love of our Eucharistic Lord. I am grateful to Fr. Wade and the Fathers of Mercy for having offered this parish mission to our community.

In this Advent season, as we prepare for the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, we are invited to come and adore him, the Son of God who humbled himself to take on human flesh and become one of us in all things but sin. As Fr. Wade reminded us, he who would be born in Bethlehem (*Bet-léhem*, which in Hebrew means "house of bread") and laid in a manger



where livestock are fed, would again humble himself on the night of Holy Thursday, to institute the Eucharist as a perpetual memorial of his passion, death, and resurrection, allowing us to be fed with the Bread of Life, his very Body and Blood, until he comes again.

This Thursday, December 14th, we will launch our weekly Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, to continue every Thursday, from 9:30 AM to 9 PM. Thank you to those who signed up for an hour to come every Thursday to ensure that our Lord will be accompanied at all times. Even if you did not sign up, you are welcome to stop by for a visit at any moment on Thursdays. I have asked Elizabeth Costa to oversee our Thursday adoration, so should you have any questions, or if you would still like to sign up for an hour, or in the future are no longer able to come at your scheduled time, you can contact her at (209)585-6557.

I decided to have our weekly adoration on Thursdays precisely because our Lord found it fitting to institute the Holy Eucharist, and the priesthood which is at the service of the Eucharist, on Holy Thursday. Later that night, Jesus would go to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray to the Father before his arrest and asked his disciples to pray as well. When they were falling asleep, Jesus asked them, "could you not watch with me one hour?" (Mt 26:40). The Lord invites us to spend an hour (or whatever moments we might have) with him, praying for so many needs in our lives and in the world. Each of us, I'm sure, has so many intentions resting in our hearts which we can bring to Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament: for our children and our family members, particularly those estranged from the Church, for ourselves and for the virtues that we need to grow in holiness, for those who are sick, for our beloved dead, for our nation, for an end to the offenses against human life in the world… so many needs for which we can pray. Since Holy Thursday was the moment in which Jesus instituted the priesthood in order to administer his Body and Blood, in addition to all the personal intentions you may have, I would ask you to pray especially for the following intentions:

- 1) vocations to the priesthood in our diocese
- 2) our seminarians
- 3) our Holy Father, Pope Francis
- 4) our Bishop, Myron Cotta and the priests of our diocese
- 5) me

Jesus waits for us in the Blessed Sacrament. Let us spend an hour each Thursday adoring him and praying with him to the Father for all of our needs. The Lord is never outdone in generosity. Let us keep him company. Let us adore him in the Most Blessed Sacrament, now and forever!




