

# BECOMING CATHOLIC OCIA (FORMERLY RCIA)

### ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) is the process for adults who desire to join the Catholic faith and for those seeking more information on the Catholic Church. OCIA can also be a method for Catholics to complete their reception of the initiation sacraments. The rite is designed for adults "who after hearing the mystery of Christ proclaimed, consciously and freely seek the living God."

### WHO IS OCIA FOR?

- Non-Catholics who want to find out more about the Catholic Faith
- Those who want to join the Catholic Church through Baptism, or Profession of Faith
- Those who were baptized Catholic as infants but never received religious education, Confirmation, or First Eucharist.

### Where?


In the parish hall Youth Room (Park behind the hall and enter through the Southeast corner door.)

# The Synod Corner

In October 2021, the Diocese of Stockton began the journey of planning and conducting the diocesan phase of the Synod on Synodality. Parishes throughout the

diocese held listening session in which over 2000 people participated.

In addition, approximately 1600 people participated in the online survey. The results of the listening sessions and online survey were synthesized into a report that was sent to the United States



Conference of Catholic Bishops. This report plus all the reports from the dioceses throughout the United States were made ready for the working document for the Synod of October 4 – 29, 2023. 


