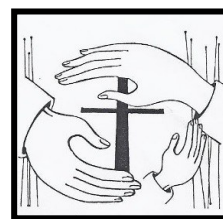

Sanctity of Life

January 2026

“If you want, equal justice for all and true freedom and lasting peace, then America, defend life.” Pope St. John Paul II
With these inspiring and challenges words, St. John Paul II said it all!

“The God of Israel, the God of Jesus Christ, is a God of life, a God of the living. He hates death and the ways of death,” says Bishop Robert Barron. The ministry of Jesus is centered in his triumphant of life over death - his Resurrection. In other words: His ministry is a ministry of life!

When a society is fixated upon promoting a culture of death, it will manifest a total disregard for human life and dignity which will not bring blessings upon us. We must beware that social justice begins in the womb.

St. Mother Teresa’s bold and prophetic words jolt us into a greater awareness of the sanctity of unborn life: “I feel the greatest destroyer of peace, today, is abortion, because it is a war against the child...A direct killing of the innocent child, murdered by the mother, herself...And if we can accept that a mother can kill even her own child, how can we tell other people not to kill one another?” Mother continues: “We must not be surprised when we hear of murders, of killings, wars, of hatred. If a mother can kill her own child, what is left but for us to kill each other. “

The sin of abortion rejects the truth- life is a good and gift that finds its origin in God, a perfect gift that deserves protection. This brings us to the bottom line: “Killing is never the solution to address our culture problems.” We must not succumb to the influence of evil but remain true to God’s gift of life. With God’s grace and mercy, we must accompany those who desire to rise out of the darkness of abortion by leading them to healing and wellbeing, reconciliation with God, themselves and their unborn.

Our diocesan offices: Life & Dignity and Marriage & Family Life can assist individuals by directing them to such programs as: Rachel’s Vineyard and Project Rachel. For those who choose to give birth, and may find themselves in desperate need, the Church is there to accompany them by means of outreach programs such as “Walking with Moms.” When necessary, we, as the Body of Christ, the Church, are called to be with mother and child after birth.

As we continue to be sent by the Lord Jesus to evangelize, and accompany one another, we are reminded of the words of Bishop Michael Burbidge, who served on the USCCB Committee of Pro-Life Activities: “Our work is not only to change laws, as you know, but to change hearts and minds, to inspire, and to inform.”

Truth in love!

May we continue to pray and uphold the sanctity and gift of life, born and unborn, especially, now, during this Month of Respect Life. In this New Year, 2026, let us draw close to the Truth - Jesus - He who came so that we “might have life and have it more abundantly” (John 10:10).

May the peace of the *Lord of Life* be with you!

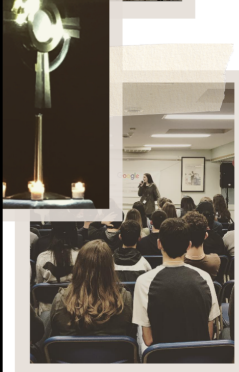

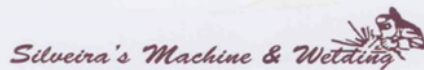
