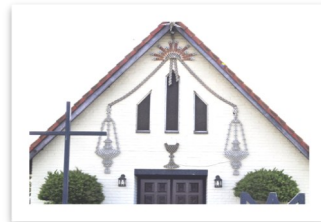

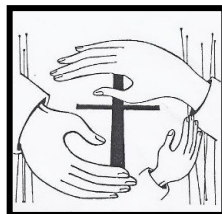



BISHOP'S MONTHLY REFLECTION

May 2026

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

May the peace of the Risen Lord, Jesus, be with you!

As we welcome the month of May, the month dedicated to the Blessed Mother, we turn to her as Mother of the Lord, the Mother of the Son of God, and ask her for her powerful intercession. Under the popular titles of Our Lady of Peace and Our Lady of the Rosary, we turn to her during these troubling times for protection and for the grace of conversion of mind and heart.

Our Lady reminds us that the remedy for the *warring factions* within the human heart is prayer, conversion, the surrender of our lives to her Son Jesus and his Divine Mercy. We are called to trust, and not to fear, for she is the one who will lead us to God and Mercy, itself- Jesus! It is Jesus who has told us: "Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My mercy." He emphasizes that his mercy is a "last hope of salvation."

Also, Our Lady reminds us of a powerful means that we have at our disposal which can be utilized in times of *warfare*. And what is this weapon? Prayer – especially that of the Holy Rosary!

Throughout history, the Rosary has had an impact on world events. As followers of Christ, we know that prayer can heal the *hardened heart*. Through the grace of conversion and God's mercy, prayer can help to counteract sin and thus grant hope for peace in the world.

Our Lady encourages *all* the faithful to take up the Rosary. She asks us to devoutly pray it daily, in order to attain peace and to bring about an end to the warring factions *within* hardened hearts, and to bring us into the peace of the redemptive presence of Jesus.

Of course, we need to believe and trust that prayer can make a difference. In addition, we need to continue to prayerfully pursue and entrust all efforts in promoting peace: dialogue, treaties, alliances, ceasefires, etc., to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

In regard to the Rosary, Our Lady reminds us that it is in *praying*, and not just *saying* the prayers of the Rosary and, more importantly, it is in meditating upon the Gospel-based Mysteries of the Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious, and Luminous Mysteries - that we discover the heart and strength of the Rosary. My friends, that is its power! The Rosary is Christ-centered!

So, as the Diocesan Church: are you willing to join me as your bishop to "get on board" with this or not? We need families, the *domestic church*, to commit to this heavenly request from the Mother of Jesus. Are you willing to pray the Rosary daily for peace, especially during this month of May?

So, are we "on board?" Are we in agreement?

The peace and future of the world depends on it!

We are reminded, as Jesus carried his cross, of his prophetic words to the women of Jerusalem, in reference to the future chastisement of the fall of Jerusalem: "Do not weep for me, but for you and your children."

May Jesus, through the intercession of his Blessed Mother, preserve us from war and the horror of all its repercussions.

Our Lady of Peace, pray for us!

Our Lady of the Rosary, pray for us! Amen.

Catechism Coordinator - Part-time

The Catechism Coordinator is responsible for coordinating catechetical program and faith formation sessions for children in 1st through 6th grade, as well as, recruiting and training adult volunteers to facilitate catechetical sessions. The Catechism Coordinator administrates (designs, directs and evaluates) an Elementary (1st -6th grade) catechetical program and provides leadership to assist the parish youth, young adults, and adults in building a solid foundation for spirituality, Christian living, ministry, and outreach.

This position implements the parish's commitment to faith formation in a comprehensive manner. A high degree of interpersonal skills is necessary including the ability to recruit and motivate adult catechists. The Catechism Coordinator both organizes the people and events that serve to evangelize our youth and their families, and he/she also engages in direct relational ministry to youth.

Confirmation Coordinator - Part-time

Our Lady of the Assumption Parish is seeking a faith-filled and organized individual to serve as our Confirmation Coordinator. This position is responsible for coordinating the parish Confirmation program for youth preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, and when necessary, assisting with sacramental preparation for Baptism, First Penance, and First Eucharist for case-specific students.

The Confirmation Coordinator works collaboratively with parish staff, catechists, parents, and volunteers to foster a vibrant and welcoming environment of faith formation and evangelization for teens and their families. This position oversees the development and implementation of the Confirmation catechetical process, recruits and trains volunteer catechists and aides, and supports families as they accompany their children in their sacramental journey.

The ideal candidate will possess strong interpersonal and organizational skills, a love for the Catholic faith, and the ability to inspire and support youth, parents, and volunteers alike. Responsibilities include coordinating program logistics and

sacramental records, maintaining communication with families, overseeing program resources and materials, monitoring the program budget, and collaborating with parish leadership and other faith formation ministries.

Candidates should demonstrate a commitment to ongoing faith formation and professional development through participation in workshops, conferences, and diocesan training opportunities.

Youth and Young Adult Coordinator - Part-time

This position is responsible for evangelizing teens and young adults in the doctrine, goals and mission of the Church. This position provides ministries that are inviting, formal catechesis, and promotes faithful and sacramental lives of participants. Assists the Parish to become a more welcoming community and engages in direct relational ministry to youth.

The youth and young adult coordinator is energetic, dynamic, and will collaboratively develop a vision for youth and young adult ministry in the parish. A high degree of interpersonal skill is necessary including the ability to recruit and motivate new teens and young adults.

As a representative of the Roman Catholic Church, the coordinator is expected to be a faithful and practicing Catholic adhering to the goals and mission of the Church. 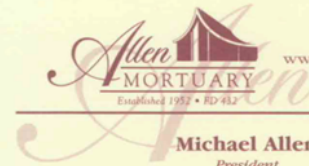

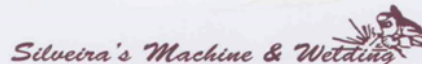
